- HDD [Hard Drive], your pc or laptop.
- External HDD, SSD solid state drive, FD.
- Cloud, Google, OneDrive, Dropbox.
- Google, 20gb free, or 3.49\$ for 100Gb.
- OneDrive (Microsoft) 1Tb. (1000Gb) with Ms Office
- Adobe, lightroom, online storage is available in plans.
- IG, Facebook,
- PicFair, for selling, or though online portfolios.
- Website, home hosting, online hosting, WordPress, square space, GoDaddy, cost of a name (www....), SmugMug.
- 52 frames, guru-shots. Are competitions and games but also make an album.

- HDD,; a crash, life span of 10 years, heavy some have power needs. (adapters)
- SSD: Small, life span of 25 to 30 years if used often, 100 years if only used to save pictures.
- Cloud: go with a "big" well-known company, as they don't disappear.
- Some storage is free some cost money per month, some do offer free storage on plans we already have, {Office Microsoft, Lightroom Adobe, }
- Social media, is sometimes a good way but accounts can disappear, deleted or moved.
- Selling sights, PicFair, Shootproof, shutter stock, works for some, best topics are product photography or backgrounds.
- Owning your own website, costs are the name, and the hosting, (hosting is the space you have online) also a thing to know is traffic. The price of a high traffic (lots of visitors/ viewers) is higher then a low traffic site.
- Competitions and Games. And store most times an album too.
